Our efforts to assess community needs help us determine what facilities are needed. Since 2017 we have gathered needs data from hundreds of people in our community in several ways:

- **Cornell University's DesignConnect program:** Their team hosted community meetings, did community surveys, and helped TCR visualize the original recreation campus concept, all to evaluate community needs.
- Local Recreation Groups Surveys: In 2019, and again in 2023, we reached out to local groups to better understand their needs, facilities, and ways they promote their programs.
- **Regional Census Data:** In 2017 we reviewed census data to get a sense of how our local population may change over the coming decade.
- Monthly Newsletter Feedback: Each month we field feedback, questions, and comments from folks in our community asking about new recreational spaces for our community

A. DESIGN Connect

In 2017, we worked with the team from Cornell to develop a Community Needs Assessment and gather feedback and a recreational wish list from our community members. We coordinated several public meetings and surveys to gather feedback from community members.



What we discovered:

Population growth is trending up in the Town of Ulysses. There is evidence showing a **15-30%** increase of **29-34 year-olds, and young families** in the immediate Trumansburg area in the coming decade. And with the new INHS Crescent Way property under construction now, we expect another bump in population growth.

"Although we are allowed to use school facilities, there just isn't the ease of access and support that used to be in this community. I would be in support of a facility that gave our kids more access to play baseball/softball that was not as restrictive as the spaces at the school."
